WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS:



Cooking/Baking– Depending on interest, there might be two Foods workshops– cooking and baking, or just one “Foods” workshop. They will be geared toward, but not limited to the Baking 101, and Cooking 101 projects with activities from the project book.



Poultry– Come learn some basics in taking care of your birds, how to clip their feathers (which needs to be done at least 3 months before Fair), and how to get them ready for a show.

Intro to Shooting Sports – Come learn about Shooting Sports and what projects and opportunities you can explore. Shooting Sports is a safe, fun, and challenging activity that can become a lifelong passion. Come learn more about it!



Crochet- This will be a fun informal workshop for any Crocheter, regardless of your skill level. If you want, you can bring a project you are already working on. Yarn and hooks will be made available at the class. Even if you aren't taking Crochet, you are welcome to join.



Knitting– Depending on interest and skill level of participants, we will try to offer a knitting workshop as well– most likely at the same time and location as Crochet.

Photography– Come learn how you can use the Photography project to improve your picture-taking skills, along with how to get the most from your project book without it feeling like “work.”



Shop Safety/ Tool Usage–

Are you interested in a Wood-working, Welding, Small Engines, or other Shop-related project? Basic Shop Safety and Tool identification/usage is an important step. Even if you aren't taking one of those project in 4-H, you are welcome to come learn more about Shop-related projects, safety, and tools.



Gardening– Spring is around the corner, and soon we will be getting ready to plant our gardens. Get a jump-start on your garden project so you are ready once the snow melts. Also, come learn how you can turn your project into blue ribbon exhibits at the fair.
