Location

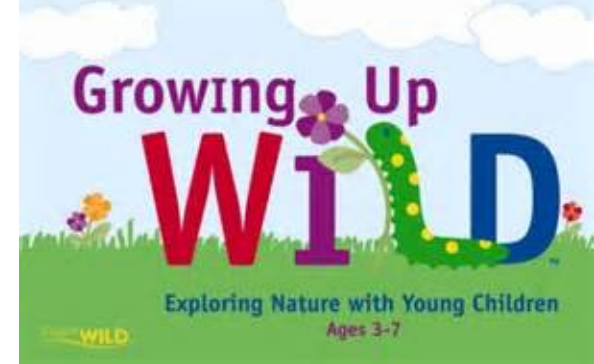
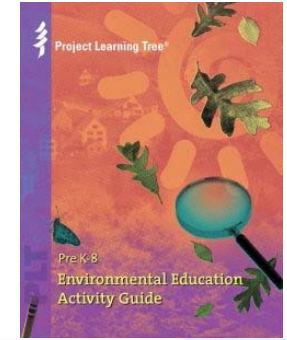
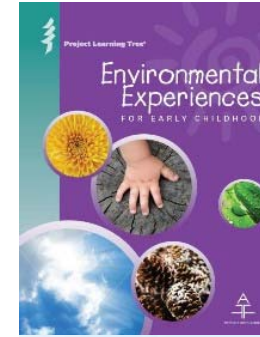
Participants meet at Montana Wild, 2668 Broadwater Ave, Helena (across from Kessler School).
