Greetings,

You are invited to be an interview judge at the Gallatin County Fair for 4-H youth exhibiting 4-H projects July 16 -18, 2017. Interview evaluation is the final step for a 4-H member to complete their project. Interview judges will evaluate the 4-H member's record book as well as their knowledge of their project. This is a great chance for the youth to share their knowledge, practice interviewing, and present themselves and their accomplishments to a caring adult.

We would like the judges to have some subject knowledge of the projects that they will be judging. We will have a short 20 minute judge's orientation before each session to go over the judging forms and what to look for when judging the record books and interviews. We will have break times with lunch or dinner, along with snacks and drinks for all interview judges.

Additionally we are looking for judges the indoor projects items on Tuesday, July 18th. Judges will review entries in their area of comfort and award the project a ribbon along with selecting the best of show.

The Horse interviews will take place in the Indoor Arena and the Livestock/Small Animal and Indoor interviews will be in Exhibit Building 3 at the Gallatin County Fair Grounds.
