- 5) Have your 4-H enrollment card filled out and turned in to the Extension Office by December 1, 2009
- 6) Attend the Quality Assurance training on Tuesday, December 29, from 10—noon at the Ronan Community Center
- 7) Wear warm clothes and boots to weigh-in.

Thank you to all who sold fruit and to those who helped unload and sort. Hopefully all orders have been delivered and families are enjoying the delicious oranges and grapefruit.


