

Dear Park County 4-H / FFA Member,

It is time to pick the entries that you want to exhibit for each of your 4-H projects at the fair. To help you do this we have enclosed a:

1. Park County 4-H fairbook-**New changes are summarized on page 7**
2. Park County 4-H General entry form
3. Livestock entry form
4. Rodeo Entry Form

**General Entry Form:** The fairbook is organized into departments, classes, and lots. Each project area has its own department. Please find your project areas (there is a table of contents at the front of the fairbook) and select the classes and lots which you are eligible to exhibit at the fair. Write down the entries on the general entry form.

For example: If you exhibit a purebred boy rabbit that is over one year old, flip to the rabbit section of the fairbook. Use the fairbook to find the department, class, and lot. On your general entry form, write:

Department,	Class	Lot	Description	Animal Name or Tag # if market	Sell Y/N

Make sure to put the name down in the “Animal Name” blank. If market, please put the tag #. Indicate whether or not you want to sell it at the auction. Keep writing down entries until you have selected all that you want to enter. **Don’t forget to enter showmanship if you are exhibiting an animal. It is at the end of each Animal Project area of the Fairbook.**

**Livestock Entry Form:** Please use one line for each animal and please indicate how many pens or stalls you will need for your project.

**Park County Fair Sale:** 4-H members are allowed to sell two items with the exception:

- If you are a steer member, you can only sell 1 steer, but you can also sell something else.

Please fill out the entry forms and get them back to the Extension Office by **Wednesday June 22nd, 2011**. Entries received after June 22nd, are charged a \$10.00 late fee. **Entries will not be accepted after July 1st, 2010.**

After we have received your fair entries, we will schedule you a time for the project judging, (journals, cooking, animal requirements, etc.) and will be sending you additional paper work with your judging time. All indoor exhibits and market animal requirement interviews will occur on Monday, August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011.

**Made in 4-H Auction sign ups are Monday, August 1, from 1-5 pm. 4-H members must sign-up during this time to sell at the Park County Fair Sale.**
