Dear 4-H Textile Members:

Registrations, found on the website [www.msueextension.org/teton](http://www.msueextension.org/teton), for the style show are **due June 5**. A **late fee of \$5** will be charged per late entry. **Scripts are not due until June 18**. The textile show **judging** for quilts and garments will take **place by scheduled appointment starting at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 18**. **The public style show will be at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, June 26** in the Choteau City Park.

Judges score sheets and examples of scripts are located on our website for your use. You may submit your scripts/registration by e-mail if you would like – simply include the information listed on the form. Send to [jwolery@montana.edu](mailto:jwolery@montana.edu), if submitting electronically. If you need suggestions for writing scripts, please contact me. We will follow the “4-H – Skills Under Construction!” theme that we are using for fair, if you can incorporate that appropriately into your scripts. Be creative and have fun writing the scripts.

Any 4-H member who is enrolled in at least one textile project area can compete in any textile area during the textile show. For example, if a member is enrolled in clothing, they may still model a knit item, even though they are not enrolled in knitting. If a member is enrolled in quilting, they may still enter and model a garment, whether or not it has any quilting incorporated in the garment.

  - **List of garments/quilts and interview time requested**
- **June 18 Textile Judging, tentatively at Choteau Baptist Church**
  - **Bring finished scripts at this time**
  - **Activities are being planned for the waiting area during judging**
- **June 26 Public style show at Choteau City Park during the fair**

While we encourage members to attend both the judging and public shows, if a member can only make one of the two events, we have typically accommodated schedules. The only time to be judged, however, is June 18. If a member cannot attend the judging, but still wants to model at the public show, we encourage you to do so. If members have scheduling conflicts and would like their garments and/or quilts judged, a video submission will be accepted. Registrations for video submissions still need to be in the office by June 5. Arrangements for video submissions need to be made with Jane Wolery at least a week prior to the event.
