Members must complete the camp counselor application, which is enclosed, by **February 16**. Please note that references (as requested) may be called and asked a series of questions related to your reliability, ability to work with people, and your worthiness as a candidate for counselor. **Selections of counselors will be made based on completed application, reference checks, meeting involvement and contributions to planning.** Interviews will be scheduled, only if deemed necessary. You will be contacted regarding planning meetings. There is typically one meeting per month and one 24-hour planning retreat.

4-H counselors are expected to attend as many camp planning meetings as possible, retreat and 4-H camp.
