Purchasing 4-H livestock can be used as a deduction!

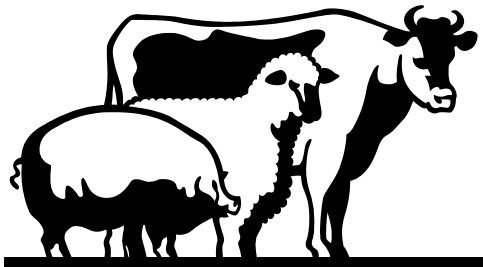
