Organization and Order	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tabs to designate/separate years in 4-H. • Suggested order: My 4-H Year, Project and Financial Journal and Animal Journal together for same project. 	10		
4-H Involvement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Documented in record book: attendance at club meetings, fair, other county and state events. 	10		
Community Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4-H, church, school, scouts, family, personal contributions to others in the community, donations of time and money to projects, etc. 	10		
Project Journal/ Animal Record	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Goals • Completeness. • Sequential development. • Pictures of the specific project. 	15

Financial Journal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accuracy. • Clarity of thought. • Clear answers for questions begin asked. • Completeness-even if it did not cost you directly, the time had a value. Assign a value based on market practices. • Include all income and expenses. Premiums earned count as income. Expenses may be list of basic ingredients and costs-cost of flour, chocolate chips, items in your home used. Feed expenses for animals should be included and assessed at the market value, even when using family-owned feed. Veterinary expenses, expenses to travel to meetings, fair, film developing. 	15
