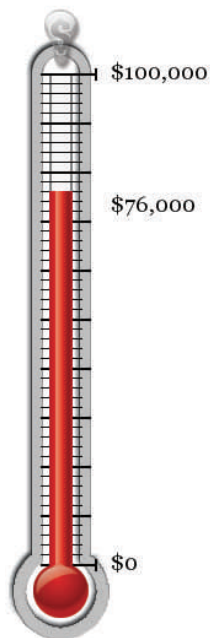


## **Taylor Challenge Update - (4-H Foundation Fundraiser)**
