

Age Requirements for Valley County 4-H Projects and Activities

Program	Age Requirement
Cloverbud	6-8 years old, during the 4-H year, can only enroll in Cloverbud Project
4-H Member	9 years old anytime during 4-H year, (October 1 – September 30)
Pre Junior member	9-10 years old by October 1 of the current 4-H year
Junior member	11-13 years old by October 1 of the current 4-H year
Senior member	14 years and older by October 1 of the current 4-H year
Montana Citizenship Seminar – Helena	14 years and older by October 1 of the current 4-H year
Montana Rec Lab Participant	13 years and older by October 1 of the current 4-H year
Montana 4-H Congress – Bozeman	14 years and older by October 1 of the current 4-H year
State Exchange	Completed 6 th grade to host Completed 7 th grade to travel
Washington D.C. Trip	Must be 15 by October 1 of the 4-H year of the trip
Horse Project Colt to Maturity	12 years and older by October 1 of the current 4-H year
Breeding Beef	9 years and older by October 1 of the current 4-H year 9-11 year olds may show at halter a yearling heifer only
Market Steer	11 years and older by October 1 of the current 4-H year
Small animal projects	9 years old and older during the 4-H year
