GENERAL SWINE RULES:

1. All breeders and feeders are eligible
2. Refer to overall livestock exhibit rules, livestock building rules, livestock sale rules, and 4-H Code of Ethics.

SPECIAL MARKET SWINE RULES:

1. Each club's 4-H livestock committee member may pick up 2(two) tags for each member of their club enrolled in the 4-H Market Swine Project before **May 15 of current year**. Suggested weight at this time is between 40 lbs and 70 lbs. If two (2) swine are tagged, only one can be entered in Class 100, Lot 1.
2. Market Swine are required to be purchased & tagged in the right ear no later than **May 15 of current year** to be eligible to compete at the fair and sell at the Valley County 4-H & FFA Livestock Sale.
3. On entry day, Market Swine must weigh a minimum of 175 pounds to show and only hogs that weigh 200 lbs will be eligible to sell at the Valley County 4-H & FFA Livestock Sale.
4. Swine will be divided into weight classes by the Swine Superintendents after they have been weighed on entry day. Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded in each weight division
5. Barrows and gilts are eligible, may be of any breed or cross.
6. Reproductive defect in barrows will be disqualified.
7. Cryptorchidism in barrows will be disqualified.
8. Refer to the Livestock Sale Rules.
9. Swine superintendents may make spot project visits to assist you with the project and check for proper application of ear tags.
