As approved by the 4-H Livestock Committee, 4-H members with animal projects need to complete the following:

Level 1: Members need to complete 7 activities each year for a total of 21 activities over a 3-year period. After 3 years in Level 1, members must move to Level 2.

Level 2: Members need to complete 4 activities the first year, 4 activities the second year, and 2 activities the third year. After 3 years in Level 2, members must move to Level 3.

Level 3: Members need to complete 3 activities the first year, 3 activities the second year, and 3 activities the third year. After 3 years in Level 3, members must move to Independent Study.
