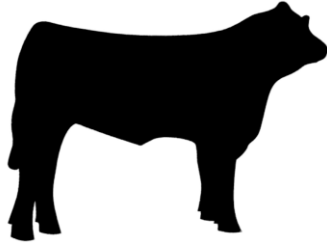
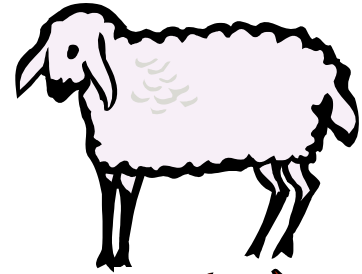

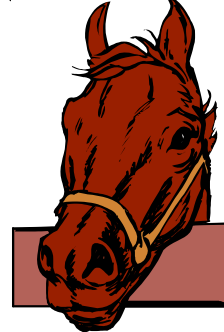


4-H SHOWMANSHIP CLINIC JUNE 25, 2010
