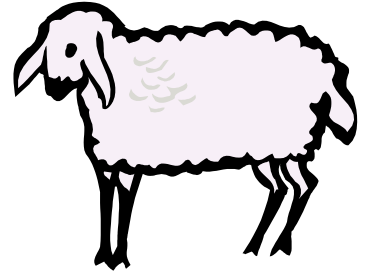

**WEIGHING & TAGGING 4-H MARKET LAMBS & HOGS
JUNE 3, 2009**



The date to weigh and tag 4-H market lambs and hogs has been set for **Wednesday, June 3rd, at 4:00 p.m. at the Fairgrounds.** Four-H members wishing to exhibit a market lamb or hog at the fair must have them tagged. Each 4-H member is also eligible to tag an alternate animal. The alternate animal must be designated at weigh-in. All sheep and goats exhibited at the fair, regardless of sex, must also have a Scrapie tag.
